### **Welcome!**

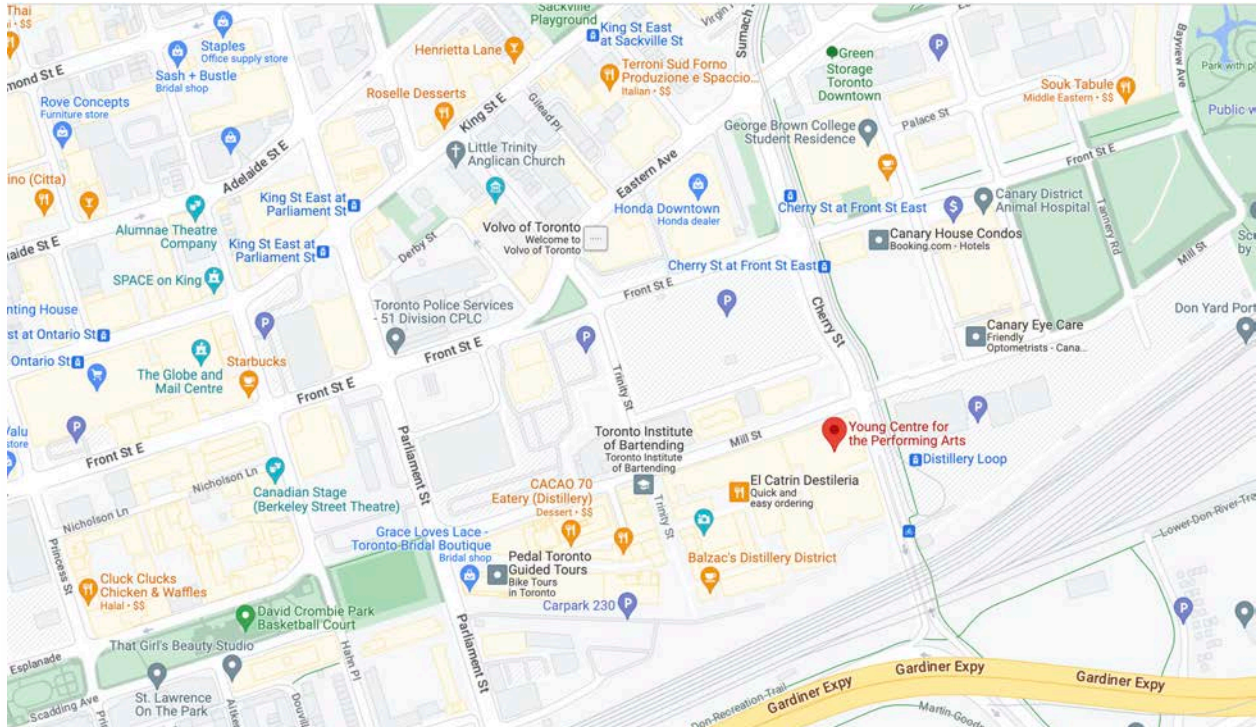

## Getting Here

Tank House Theatre is located in the Young Centre for the Performing Arts at the corner of Cherry Street and Tank House Lane. The address is 50 Tank House Lane. This is two blocks south of Front Street East and two blocks east of Parliament Street.





## **Bicycle**

There are numerous bike racks around the corner from the venue on the west side of Cherry Street. Please make sure you bring a lock to secure your bike. If you are using Bike Share, you can dock your bike at Cherry Street and Distillery Lane.



## **Bus**

The closest accessible bus route is 121 Esplanade-River. Get off at Cherry Street Name and make your way south. Turn right onto Tank House Lane. The theatre is approximately 300 metres from the bus stop at Front Street East and Cherry Street.



## **Streetcar**

The closest accessible streetcar route is 504A King. Get off at Distillery Loop and cross the street. The theatre is approximately 50 metres from the streetcar stop at Distillery Loop.



## **Subway**

Union Station is the closest subway station. To get to the theatre from here, take the 121 Esplanade-River bus to Cherry Street. Walk two blocks south.



## **Taxi**

There will be enough room for taxis to make pickups and drop-offs on Mill Street. Please let staff or a volunteer know if you need assistance calling a taxi.



## **Wheel-Trans**

There will be enough room for Wheel-Trans for make pickups and drop-offs at 55 Mill Street, which is one block north and one block west of the venue.



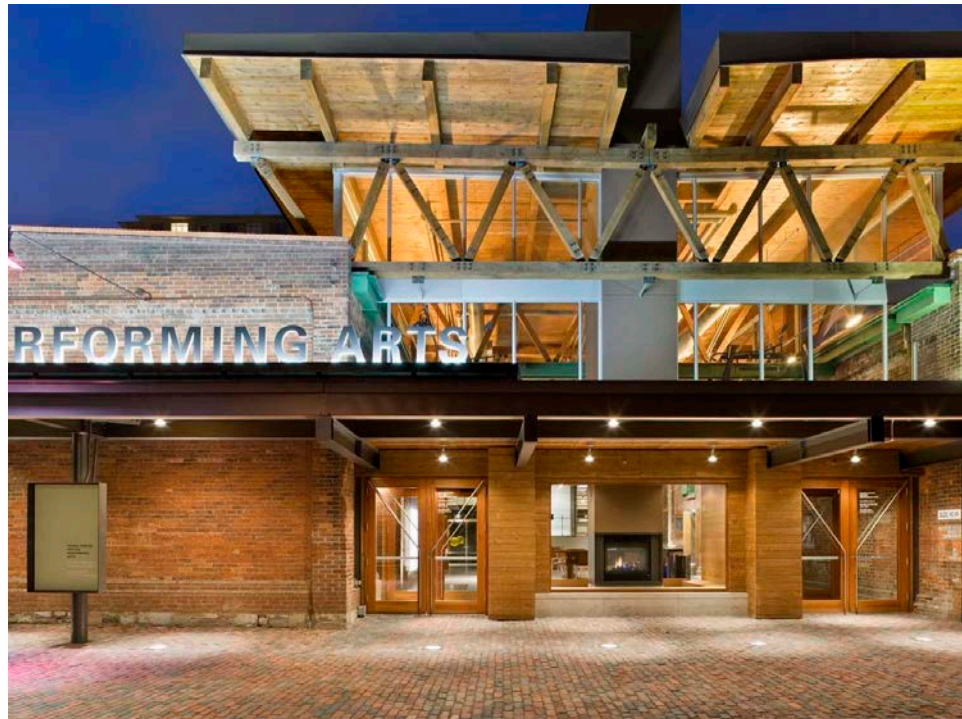
## **Parking**

Limited paid street parking is available one block north of the venue on Mill Street.

The closest paid parking lot is located at the corner of Cherry Street and Distillery Lane. The address is 70 Distillery Lane. This is one block south of the venue.

## Arriving

This is what the building looks like from the main entrance, which is on Tank House Lane.





This is what the building looks like if you are coming west from Tank House Lane.



This is what the building looks like if you are coming east from Tank House Lane.



## **Before the Show**

During the Fringe, you wait outside the theatre in the main lobby until your show is announced. This is also where our Front of House is located.

You may need to visit our Front of House if you want to:

- Indicate that you require priority seating
- Indicate that you require alternative seating
- Indicate that you require accessible seatings
- Pick up a headset and receiver for audio described performances
- Pick up earplugs or fidget toys
- Review the venue guide
- Review the access guide for select performances

Our Front of House will be located in the main lobby.

You will wait in the ticket holders' line. Ticket holders will line up on the wall opposite of the café and then continue outside, curving towards Cherry Street.

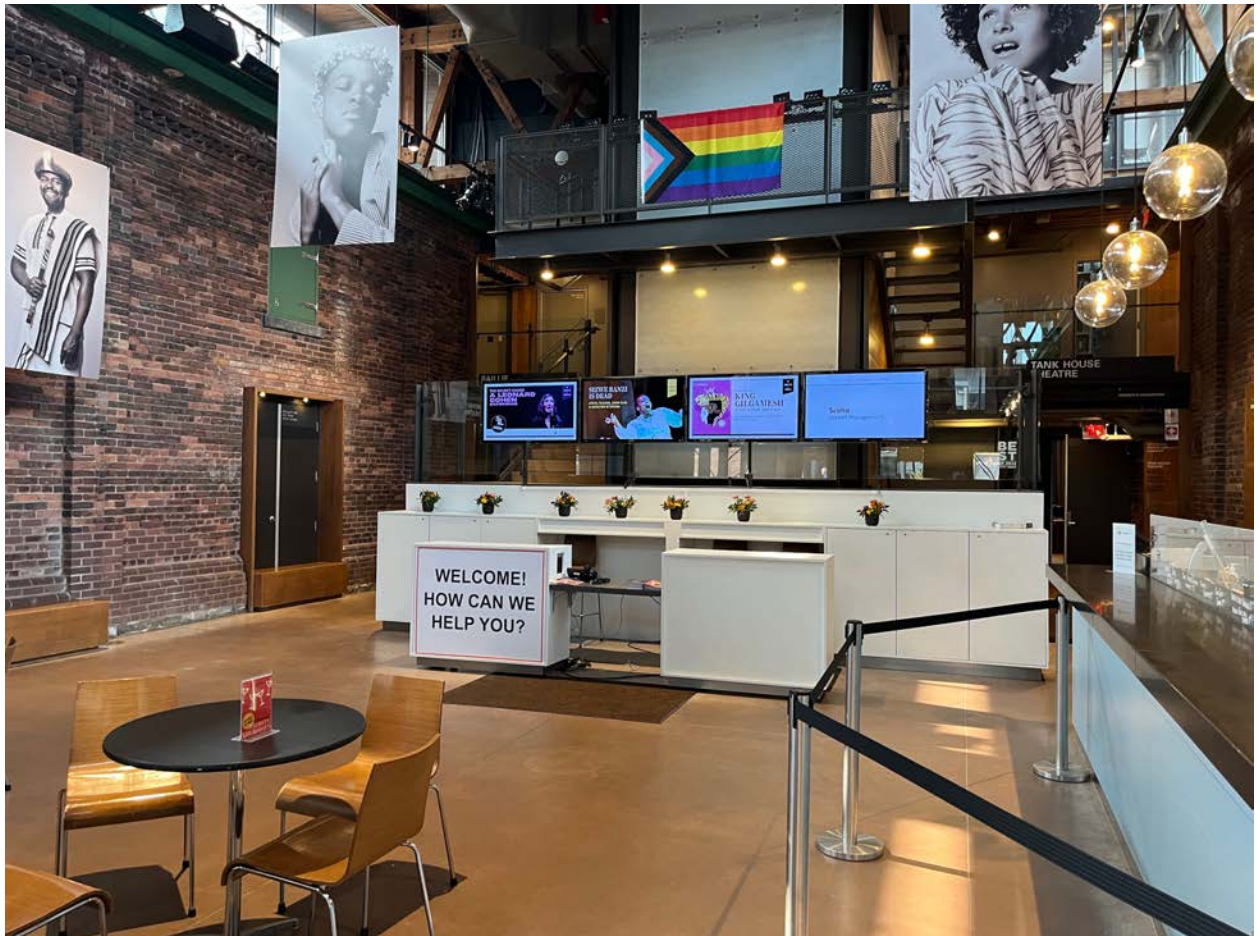


Fringe staff wear black or white t-shirts and volunteers wear purple t-shirts. They are there to help you. They are very friendly.



## Lobby

When you enter the doors, you will be in the lobby. This is what the lobby looks like:



## **Entering the Theatre**

A Front of House person will audibly announce, as well as hold up a sign, for priority seating for anyone requiring extra time. This includes patrons using accessible or alternative seating. If that's you, then you will enter.

A Front of House person will then make a general entrance announcement and hold up a sign for everyone to enter the theatre a few minutes later. If you haven't already gone in, then it's time.

## Performance Space

These are the doors to the Tank House Theatre. The Tank House Theatre is located on the main floor at the back right of the main lobby.





This is where you will sit and watch the show. You can sit in whichever seat you like! Accessible seating is located in the front row. Chairs can be removed or rearranged to accommodate mobility devices as needed.

## **During a Relaxed Performance**

If you are coming for a relaxed performance, there will be a short introduction before the show starts. Someone from the company will let you know a little about the show, characters, and if there is anything that may be surprising during the performance. You can also expect reduced sound and lighting effects. The house lights will be on at a low level so that you can enter and exit safely at any time. Audience members are free to sit or stand, make noise as they need to, or use fidgets as needed. We want you to be comfortable.

## **Quiet Zone**

If you need to leave the theatre during the show for any reason, you are welcome to sit in the quiet zone, which is located in the main lobby. You may still hear some of the sounds from the show while you are in the quiet zone, but it will be quieter than inside the theatre space.

## Washrooms

There is a women's washroom on the main floor at the back of the lobby to the right near the entrance to the Tank House Theatre. There is an automatic door opener on this washroom.



There is a men's washroom on the main floor off the main lobby near the cafe. There is an automatic door opener on this washroom.



There is also a single occupancy accessible washroom on the second floor, which is accessible by elevator. There is an automatic door opener on this washroom.

Please note that this washroom is in a locked hallway, so please ask staff or a volunteer for assistance getting to the accessible washroom on the second floor.
